DISTRIBUTION OF THE FFY 2020 FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION SECTION 5307/5340 URBANIZED AREA APPORTIONMENTS ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE KINGSTON URBANIZED AREA

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Transportation Council (UCTC) has been designated by the Governor of the State of New York as a Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) responsible, together with the State, for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process for the Kingston Urbanized Area and a portion of the Poughkeepsie-Newburgh Orange County Urbanized area; and,

WHEREAS, the federal surface transportation programs that are the responsibility of the Ulster County Transportation Council are authorized by the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act (Pub. L. 112-141, December 4, 2015); and

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307/5340 Small Urban funds have been allocated to the Governors of States having populated areas greater than 50,000 but less than 200,000; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has further delegated his authority to the Commissioner of the New York State Department of Transportation to distribute FTA Section 5307/5340 funds; and

WHEREAS, the UCTC desires to distribute its allocation of FTA Section 5307/5340 Small Urban funds to eligible public transportation operators in the metropolitan areas; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of New York State in accordance with the required FTA processes has identified Ulster County Area Transit as sole Designated Recipient eligible to receive transit funding; and

WHEREAS, the UCTC, in cooperation with the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) and public transit providers, has reviewed and documented compliance of its planning process with adopted *UCTC Operating Procedures*, UCTC public notice procedures, and all existing federal rules and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the UCTC agrees that the County of Ulster, as Designated Recipients of FTA Section 5307 Small Urban funds within the Kingston metropolitan area, shall be awarded the total amount of **\$1,039,654** as identified in Table 1 of Attachment 1; be it further

RESOLVED, that the UCTC authorizes the UCTC Administrative Committee consisting of representatives of the Ulster County Planning Department; the NYS Department of Transportation Regional and Main Offices; the Federal Transit Administration, and the Federal Highway Administration authority to program FTA
