  - a) <u>Draft Resolution 2016-06: Amendment to the UCTC 2014 2018 UCTC Transportation Improvement Program.</u> NYSDOT Local Projects Unit periodically reviews local projects on the STIP to monitor "STIP performance" in order to confirm that the STIP is fiscally constrained during the 4-year STIP period. A number of local UCTC projects were identified with phases that would not meet obligation during the 4 year STIP cycle and therefore marked for amendment or modification. UCTC PIN 876122 as shown in Draft Resolution 2016-06 required the amendment of C and CI phases outside of the first four years of the 2014 TIP to 2018 (Year 5). Under UCTC TIP Amendment and Modification Procedures, schedule changes outside of the first four years of the TIP constitute an Amendment which requires UCTC Policy Committee approval.

<u>Recommended Action</u>: Discuss the Draft Resolution 2016-06 and consider forwarding to the Policy Committee for consideration and adoption (20 minutes). (20 minutes)

b) Draft Resolution 2016-07: Approval of the Draft UCTC 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program. UCTC updates the TIP every 2-3 years in accordance with federal rules and regulations. The Preliminary Draft UCTC TIP was revised and updated based on TIP/STIP Policy Guidance and Instructions issued by NYSDOT on September 10, 2015. In accordance with those instructions, UCTC staff, working closely with members of the UCTC TIP Subcommittee, developed a list of recommended projects for inclusion in the 2017-2021 program based directly on local sponsor input and available federal funds. Those recommendations were then presented to the Technical Committee at its 11/12/15 meeting for review and approval. That draft program was similarly reviewed by NYSDOT and entered in draft format into NYSDOT's accounting software in order to confirm that the UCTC local program conforms to local planning targets. The preliminary draft is now ready for public review by local project sponsors. A copy of the Draft 2017 – 2021 UCTC TIP will be circulated for Technical member review and approval.

<u>Recommended Action</u>: Discuss the Draft 2017 – 2021 UCTC Transportation Improvement Program and consider forwarding to the Policy Committee for consideration and adoption. (45 minutes)

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C) Apportionment of FTA §5307 and FTA §5339 Funds Attributable to UZA 454/Kingston Urbanized Area for FFY 2015. FTA §5307 formula funds made available to the Kingston Urbanized Area in FFY 2015 equal \$922,293. Eligible designated recipients of these funds include Kingston Citibus and Ulster County Area Transit. In addition, FTA §5339 formula funds made available to the Kingston Urbanized Area in FFY 2015 equal \$89,726.44 in FFY 2015. Eligible designated recipients of these funds include Kingston Citibus and Ulster County Area Transit. The City of Kingston and Ulster County must come to an agreement regarding a fair split of these funds before apportionment may take place.

d) Apportionment of FFY 2016 FTA Sub-regional Allocation to UZA 89/Poughkeepsie-Newburgh NY-NJ Urbanized Area. New York and New Jersey have reached agreement on the fair and rational sub-regional allocation of the FFY 2016 Sections 5307, 5339 and 5310 funds apportioned to the Poughkeepsie-Newburgh NY-NJ urbanized area (UZA89). While the distribution has not yet been discussed by the members of the Mid-Hudson TMA, the numbers will be shared with UCTC Technical Committee members in an effort to expedite eventual apportionment and distribution among eligible recipients within the three TMA MPOs.
