Proposed Amendments to the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2023-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

The Ulster County Transportation Council (UCTC) has initiated a 15 day public comment period on proposed amendments to the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2023-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and 2024/25 Unified Planning Work Program.

Transportation Improvement Program

The TIP is a five-year capital program that assigns federal funds to transportation projects located in Ulster County. The proposed amendments to the TIP are as follows:

- ▶ Resolution 2024-11: Addition of new PIN 8LC211 - Culvert replacements in Orange and Ulster Counties.
Location: Multiple
Sponsor: NYSDOT
- ▶ Resolution 2024-12: Addition of new PINs 8TU020 and 8TU021, Ulster County Area Transit Fleet Replacement.
Sponsor: Ulster County Area Transit
